CABOOLTURE HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT

The Queensland Government has committed \$352.9 million to undertake a significant expansion and redevelopment of the Caboolture Hospital, with a further \$41.7 million committed to deliver a new multi-storey carpark.

Caboolture Hospital Redevelopment Project

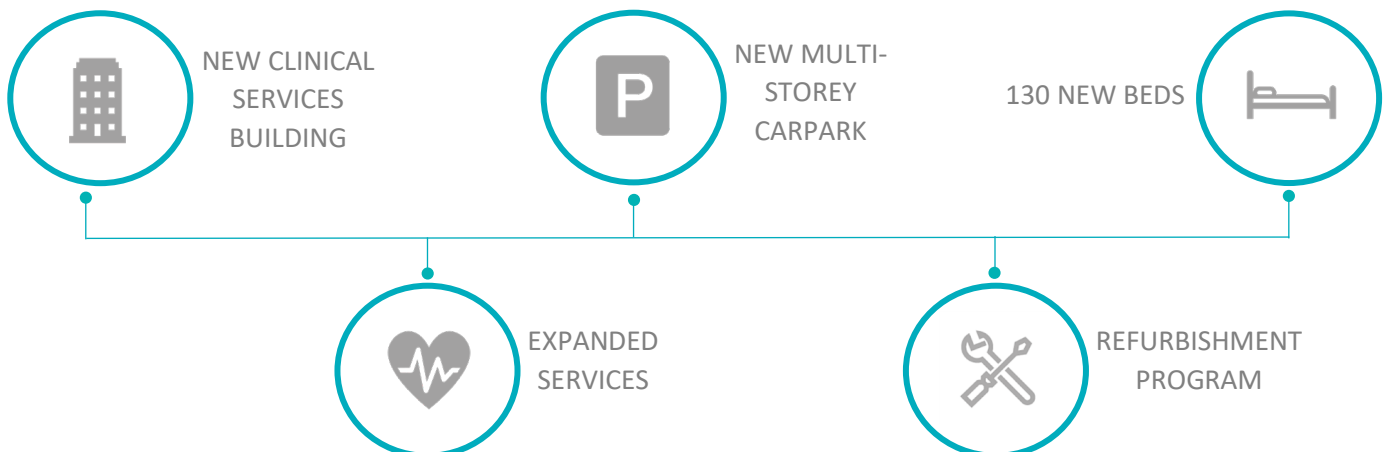
By 2031, the population of Caboolture and surrounds is expected to grow by 51%. This increase in population means Caboolture Hospital must expand to ensure we can respond to the current and future healthcare needs of our community.

Over the next four years, Caboolture Hospital will undergo a major expansion and redevelopment with a clear focus on building capacity and modernising health care services.

By 2023, the Caboolture Hospital Redevelopment will deliver:



New and expanded services

The Caboolture Hospital Redevelopment includes the construction of new facilities and refurbishment of spaces within the existing hospital, covering a gross floor area of approximately 32,000sqm.

The new five storey Clinical Services Building and the new Multi-Storey Carpark will be built at the front of the hospital. Both buildings will sit between the existing hospital and McKean Street and occupy the space currently used for public parking. Construction is expected to start in mid-2020.

New five-storey Clinical Services Building

- New and expanded Emergency Department
- 20-bed Rehabilitation Unit
- 10-bed Palliative Care Unit
- 14-bed Geriatric Evaluation and Management Unit
- 32-bed Medical Ward
- 10-bed Intensive Care Unit
- 6 (representing 2 additional) Operating Theatres and 4 Stage One Recovery Spaces
- 8-bed Cardiac Care Unit
- 4-bed Chest Pain Assessment Unit and 16-bed Medical Ward



Refurbishment in existing Hospital

- Enhanced and expanded Special Care Nursery with 15 bays
- Medical Day Unit
- Upgraded and expanded Morgue
- Expanded Medical Records Facility, Pharmacy and Pathology
- New Main Entry, Café and Visitor's Lounge

Multi-Storey Carpark

- Approximately 1,080 parking spaces in a mix of multi-story and at-grade facilities
- Accessible parking spaces, electric vehicle charging bays and motorcycle parking.
